

1906 Arts and Craft jugs, inscribed on base Omar Ramsden & Alwyn Carr. Hammered silver, the glass bodies are joined to the irregular foot by 6 silver straps hinged at the top and bottom. The Concave neck is attached to the handle by swirling tendrils.

ARTS & CRAFT FLAGONS

Sometimes, for larger services when additional wine may be needed, the wine is consecrated in a large flagon or jug. The Canons (Laws) of the Church of England stipulate that these should be made of silver, with a single scrolling handle and a hinged lid.

Many of the sacred items in this exhibition are silver (or silver gilt) and donated for this use by members of the congregation over the years.
