We are now in Passiontide and fast approaching the moving and inspiring liturgies of Holy Week. The full list of services is on the front page of this newsletter, and places at all major services must be booked through Evenbrite. We do



very much hope that you will be able to share in this journey which lies at the heart of our Christian faith, and which offers us the hope of new life, together with the knowledge that Christ himself shares in all our difficulties, grief and pain. We shall be sending out reminders of both online reflections and services in Church during the week.

We begin this Sunday – Palm Sunday – by remembering Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem, but move swiftly to hear the dramatised reading of his Passion and Death at our 9.30 am Eucharist. MARGY FITTER (4th March 1961 - 20th March 2021)

It is with enormous sadness that we share with you this week the news that Margy Fitter, wife of our Head Virger, Simon, died on Saturday morning. Margy's presence over the past few years has been a great gift to the St Mary Abbots community, who will remember her sunny smile, warmth, kindness and enthusiasm. Margy's talents and skills were admired as a member of the Voluntary Choir, member and then co-ordinator of the flower-arranging team, and as she played a huge but behind-the-scenes role as "Honorary Assistant Virger". Throughout lockdown, Simon and Margy's creative gifts were still offered to the church from Gloucester as they produced videos encouraging and inspiring us to make our own palm crosses and Easter gardens, and Margy also regularly read and led the responses at the daily Morning Prayer on Zoom until very recently. Margy brought friendship and support to so many of us and she will be sadly missed. Our hearts go out to Simon, as well as to Margy's sisters and their families. May she rest in peace and rise in glory.

Margy's funeral will take place tomorrow (Friday 26th March) in Gloucester, and Simon has written below with details of how to access the livestream of the service. For those who prefer to be in church or who cannot access the internet, we shall be keeping St Mary Abbots Church open between 2 pm and 3 pm tomorrow for anyone who would like to come, pray, light a candle and hold Margy – together with Simon and all her family – before God. If you are aware of anyone who cannot get online, please do share this possibility with them.

Message from Simon

Margy's funeral will be held this Friday 26th March, at 2.00pm, at St Paul's and St Stephen's Church, Gloucester. It will be taken by Fr Jonathan MacNeaney, for whose son, Caspar, Margy and Simon were delighted to be asked to be Godparents.

Because of Covid restrictions, only the immediate family will be attending.

However, it will be live-streamed, starting at 1.55pm, so everyone who would like to can see it. Here is the link you will need.

Margy will then be cremated on Maundy Thursday. Her ashes will be interred in the garden of the cloisters of Gloucester Cathedral.

Details will follow in due course. At that service, you will have a chance to donate to her chosen charity, Macmillan Cancer Support. They looked after both of us with such care, devotion skill and love, it was truly exceptional.
