It was such a joy to host our Bishop, the Rt Rev'd Dr Graham Tomlin, last week for the Confirmation Service, and to welcome thirtythree candidates from five churches into the Church of England. We pray for all our candidates as they set out on this next stage



of their journey. Please do speak to us if you might like to consider Confirmation yourself next year.

As restrictions begin to be relaxed, we are delighted that we are now receiving requests for baptisms and weddings and starting to book them into the church diary. Numbers of guests are still somewhat restricted at present, but we hope and trust that this will change as we move towards summer. Baptisms take place during the 9.30 am Eucharist on the second Sunday of each month, except during Lent, so that the adult or child being baptized can be welcomed by the worshipping community.
