

It was glorious to be with you all singing hymns together again for the first time last Sunday, and we shall be able to sing wonderful songs of praise again this week. Thank you for so kindly observing our ongoing guidelines around masking, hand-



sanitising and spacing, and especially for respecting the area in front of the lectern set aside for those who wish to be especially careful.

This Sunday we are delighted to welcome Canon Prof Peter Galloway back to preach for us at Matins, as Fr Christopher is in the middle of his holiday, and Mother Alice will be setting off on hers straight after presiding at the 9.30 am Eucharist! Mother Alice will be back for a final Sunday with us on August 22nd, before her maternity leave begins. You will see that she has been working hard to set up a Children's Chapel in the South West corner of the church, which all young families are warmly invited to use during the summer months. She, Cain and their family are very much in our prayers at this time of expectation.

You may by now have picked up that we are starting a process to draw up the church's new Mission Action Plan. We are inviting people to join us during August after specific services, to offer their views about the purpose and calling of God's Church, and how this purpose is being lived out at St Mary Abbots, or where there might be gaps. We shall also be arranging two larger meetings, one on a Saturday and one on a weekday evening in September, for further discussion. If you would like to contribute to this discernment of God's will for us, please do speak to one of us, or watch out for announcements of future meetings.

Our thoughts are with all those travelling at this time, that they may travel safely and without anxiety, and also with those unable to travel this year, or prevented from visiting those they love. Please don't hesitate to speak to one of us if there is anyone in particular you would like us to pray for.

Be to us, O Lord, a support in our setting out, a comfort by the way, a shadow in the heat, a covering in the rain and cold, a conveyance in weariness, a protection in adversity, a staff in unsteady ways, and a port in shipwreck; that, with you being our Leader, we may reach the place we seek, and at length we may return again to our home in safety.
