Message from Father Christopher

"Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it". This is how St Paul describes the church in 1 Corinthians 12, after his description of the body being made up of many members, all of whom are necessary. Over the last couple of weeks we have been thinking a lot about the range of activity which people are involved in across the church, and have



been encouraging you to think about what gifts you have and might be able to offer in the service of the church. On Sunday morning, in the Family Eucharist, we heard from people who lead our children's church; change the light bulbs (not an easy task!); look after safeguarding for us; repair our vestments; and lead our meditation group, along with many other things.

It is easy to come to church and assume that everything is taken care of by others, but as a number of areas of church life have stopped during Covid, and some people have moved on, we need a real boost in those volunteering in order to get back to the breadth of life there was before 2020. I say volunteering, but since we are all the people of God together, there is no distinction between volunteers and others. We all have a vocation in the church, whether simply praying faithfully for others, or being a churchwarden, and each is as important and necessary as the other.


