We continue to wrestle with shock and sadness as we hear of the ongoing attacks in Ukraine. The Archbishops of Canterbury and York have asked us to share in the following prayer for Ukraine:



God of peace and justice, we pray for the people of Ukraine We pray for peace and the laying down of weapons. We pray for all those who fear for tomorrow, that your Spirit of comfort would draw near to them. We pray for those with power over war or peace, for wisdom, discernment and compassion to guide their decisions. Above all, we pray for all your precious children, at risk and in fear, that you would hold and protect them. We pray in the name of Jesus, the Prince of Peace. Amen

It was very good to be able to dedicate our Ash Wednesday prayer and fasting as an opportunity to remember all those caught up in the fighting or trapped within Ukraine, and it was very uplifting to have so many of you with us in church yesterday, joining your prayers with ours.
