

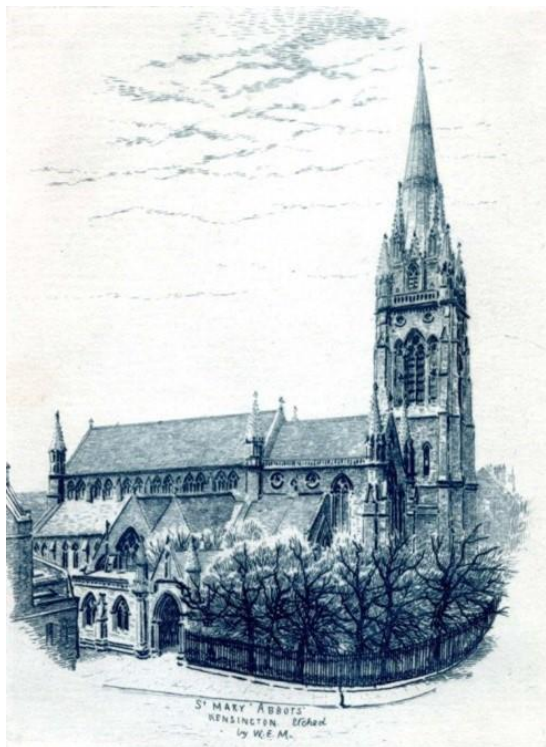

## Message from Mother Emma

The start of our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations has finally arrived! We very much hope that you will be able to join us for our Festal Eucharist at 11.15 am this Sunday at St Mary Abbots, followed by a picnic in the Vicarage gardens. Our preacher will be the Ven Richard Frank, the Archdeacon of Middlesex, and we look forward to a full choral octet singing the Mozart Coronation Mass as the setting for our Eucharist. We shall be giving thanks for all those who have served and worshipped in the parish since it was established in the eleventh century, and also recognising the generosity and skill of those who worked to create our current building, designed by Sir George Gilbert Scott. We will be praying for the future of the parish as we move forward together under God.



There will be a short Children's Eucharist at 9.30 am, for those with small children (0-5), who may then proceed to the Vicarage garden to play, but we do encourage older families to attend the main celebration, where there will be activity packs for use by children in the pews, and we hope those from our other congregations will also come together at 11.15 am to rejoice in our shared life and history together.

We are delighted to provide drinks, sandwiches and fruit at the Vicarage afterwards, but if anyone would like to bring a cake or any other contribution to the festivities that would be very gratefully received, and could be dropped off before the service or brought with you afterwards. Please also feel free to bring your own picnic if you prefer.

We are delighted to report that thanks to the wonderful fundraising efforts of Steve Attack and the Friends of St Mary Abbots, we are nearing the amount required for our new Anniversary access ramp. We shall shortly be beginning the complex business of seeking the necessary permissions before construction can begin! Thank you to everyone who has so generously contributed to this appeal, and to any who still intend to do so.

Meanwhile, a reminder from Fr Christopher that we shall be holding a lunch in church on SUNDAY 22ND for anyone interested in joining the new Outreach team, described by him in this message last week. Building on the work already done with Afghan and Ukrainian refugees, and our parish's longstanding commitment to the homeless in this area, he hopes to establish new projects and to form a group who would reflect on any outside charities we might decide to support financially as a church. 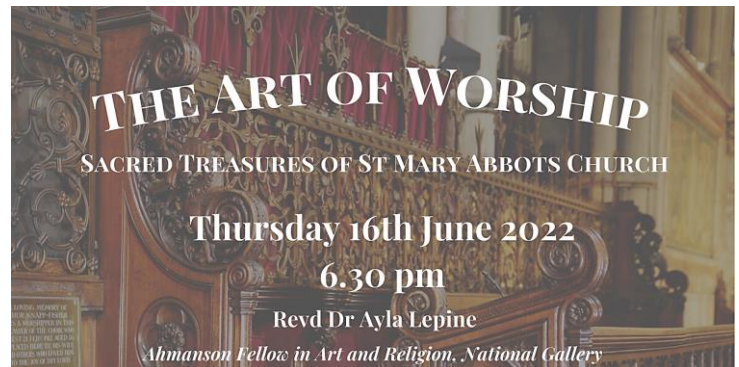
## 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Ramp Appeal

In a first step to demonstrate our Mission Action Plan commitment to give a warm and inclusive welcome, we have agreed to put in a permanent, attractive and safe ramp at the South Door to replace the existing temporary one, see below!
