It has been very good to welcome back all those who were away after Christmas, and I much enjoyed St Mary Abbots School's Epiphany Service, as well as the beautiful Choral Eucharist last week as the Three Wise



Men were finally placed in our Crib scene at the end of the Christmas season. The decorations have now all been taken down until next year, with some of our kind and generous volunteers helping Simon, and the Nativity scene has been moved to the Resurrection Chapel where it will remain until Candlemas, forty days after Christmas. Our Candlemas services (29th January), traditionally look both back towards Christ's birth and forward to the days of his Passion, and at the end, the infant Jesus is carried out as we turn from the Crib to the Cross.

As term has begun again, so have our children's activities! Many of you have told me how much you enjoyed the Family Eucharist last Sunday, and our Children's Groups will be meeting again from this Sunday.
