

Message from Mother Emma

We welcome you to our services this morning and the delight of our professional choir singing at the Eucharist as well as Matins. We will continue throughout Eastertide (up to the Feast of Pentecost on Sunday 19th May), to begin the 9.30 Eucharist at the West Doors, so



that those who later leave for Sunday School can be fully involved in the confession and absolution and the children can learn to be part of the main service, if only for four minutes! We encourage families to arrive a little early and to sit in the back pews to help your children read along with the service booklet and/or modelling praying with your hands together. Today, at Matins, we also welcome Petter, our parish manager, who is a licensed lay minister in the Deanery (at St Thomas's, Kensal Town), who will be preaching to us.

As we approach the Annual Parochial Church Meeting on Wednesday 22nd May, we are required to make sure that our Electoral Roll records are accurate and up to date. We shall be putting a list of all those on the Roll up in church ahead of this Sunday (the sidespeople will be able to show you where it is). Please do check, provided you are baptised, aged over 16 and EITHER live in the parish OR have been attending the church for more than six months, that your name is on the list. If not, please do speak to Ivell, our Electoral Roll Officer, who is known to everyone through his wonderful welcome at the South Door, and he will be able to give you a form to complete. Being on the Electoral Roll does not commit you to anything, but it does mean that you are eligible to attend the Annual Meeting and vote on issues raised, and it is very helpful for us to have an accurate picture of the congregation(s) when we apply for grants, clergy help, etc. The list will be up for two weeks, before it is closed until after the APCM.

In a fortnight's time, on Sunday 12th May, we shall be particularly celebrating our Guild of Bellringers, who draw us to worship each week with their wonderful ringing and who form, as people have said, part of the familiar "soundscape" of Kensington. Bellringers will be speaking to us briefly at each of the services, and they will also be announcing dates for visits to the bell tower for those who may be interested.

We are excited about our upcoming joint event with our neighbour, the Roman Catholic church of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and St Simon Stock on Kensington Church Street. Fr Tony Parsons of the Carmelites and our own Fr Evan will be reflecting together on Easter, Ascension and Pentecost through three works of art on Saturday 18th May (the day before Pentecost) between 10 am and 12 noon. This promises to be an inspiring and very interesting talk; entrance is free, but spaces are limited so do book via the "what is on" page on our website or contact Leonora.

May I also extend warm congratulations to another of our RC neighbours – Mgr Jim Curry, parish priest at Our Lady of Victories on the High Street and chair of Churches Together in Kensington, who has been appointed as an Auxiliary Bishop for the Diocese of Westminster.
