
Second, for all the very kind good wishes, cards and gifts my family and I have received this Christmas - we have been overwhelmed by your generosity and thoughtfulness.

Thank you message from the Food Bank

"The donations we receive on a weekly basis from the church is a lifeline for our foodbank, as it is a reliable source that we can count on. Please pass on our thanks to all the congregation and especially to the people who deliver the food on Thursday.

Our food bank service users are experiencing problems with the benefits system, ill health or challenging life experiences, and a lack of local support. For some these issues are hitting people simultaneously and leaves no protection from hunger and poverty. People are pulled into further crisis by increased pressure from heating bills, food and other essentials. We saw a marked increase in our numbers of people accessing our services over Christmas and we struggled to ensure that our Food bank and community kitchen (we provide a hot meal on the same day as the Food Bank), was well stocked. So the generous donation from your church was very much appreciated."

As you can see your donations are both vital and hugely appreciated. Any contributions should be left at the vestry as well as a list of needed items. A thank you lunch has been arranged for the food bank's volunteers on Sunday the 19th to which the Church will be contributing. For details please speak to Father Jonathan.
