As God pours his Holy Spirit upon the church the responsibility for building God's kingdom of peace and love is entrusted to his church on earth - TO US.

The liturgical colour is red, for the flames of the Holy Spirit. This is a key moment of transition in the church's year: After today Eastertide is over - so tomorrow the paschal candle is moved to stand next to the font; the Easter garden is dismantled; the colour is green as Ordinary time resumes. Today, for the last time this year, the Easter Alleluias ring out: let's sing them with the greatest gusto!


