A Prayer for those simply not interested


Lord, as all around are gripped with World Cup fever, bless us with understanding, strengthen us with patience and grant us the gift of sympathy if needed. Amen.

GRENFELL TOWER ONE YEAR ON

Last Thursday marked the first anniversary of this terrible tragedy. We continue to hold in our hearts those who bear the unimaginable scars of that night: the bereaved, the injured, the traumatised, those unable to settle in any accommodation, those guilty at surviving. They lie at the centre of our thoughts and we commit ourselves to do all that we can to support them in their continuing suffering and loss. St Mary Abbots was represented by clergy and people at all the commemorative events:

the 24 HOUR VIGIL at St Clements Treadgold Street that started at 6.00pm on Wednesday 13 June. The prayers offered at 1.30am on Thursday 14th, the moment that the fire started. The interfaith act of witness; the service at St Helen's; the Eucharist at 5.00pm at St Clements and the Thursday evening Silent March starting from nearby Notting Hill Methodist church. It was moving to see how fully all the churches, and all the other faith groups, had worked together throughout the past year in support and care for their neighbours of any faith or of none, and have forged bonds of friendship and mutual respect that offer deep hope for the continued rebuilding of a shattered community.
