Remember that for pre-school children we need one parent to stay with the child/ren - but as soon as the children reach the Butterflies it's important that the children work as a group with the Leader and Helper without the distraction of their parents in the room - so you can take part in the service in church. Of course we realise that there are times when a child might need settling and reassurance from parents or carers. We are immensely grateful to the leaders and helpers who work so hard to
