- Confidently catholic, with an openness to other forms of worship.
- Able to inspire and minister to children of all ages.
- A good listener, with emotional intelligence, and experience of life and culture.

Teaching English to Refugees

Connect & Learn is a mentoring scheme matching refugees to volunteers for 121 English language support.

Expectation -Depending on availability and needs this could be for 2 hours a week for 6 months, or for longer per week for a shorter amount of time.

Training & Support -Volunteers will receive induction training on Saturday March 16th (all day) Volunteers will receive on-going support from Migrants Organise staff.

Travel expenses will be provided to volunteers and members. **Who would benefit from this?** - This scheme has been created with people who have additional barriers to learning English; e.g. they find classroom learning difficult due to trauma, they cannot access mainstream education for various reasons such as child care barriers or perhaps they are children who have been outside of the school system for some time. Generally they have very basic and limited English. The 121 support from a volunteer will help build confidence and help overcoming practical barriers.
