If your 16th birthday falls within the next twelve months, you may complete the form now and become eligible to be entered on the Roll on your birthday.

Churches "in Communion with the Church of England" are other Anglican Churches, and certain other Churches as from time to time determined by the General Synod of the Church of England.

All persons normally RESIDENT within the Parish (map overleaf, streets within blue boundary) are entitled to immediate enrolment. *They should tick the TOP Box opposite.*

Other persons who, although resident OUTSIDE the parish boundary, habitually attend a church in this parish, and have done so for a period of six-months or longer, are also entitled to be enrolled, and to remain enrolled so long as they continue to habitually attend. *They should tick the SECOND (middle) Box opposite.* You may remain on the roll if you are prevented from regular attendance by reason of illness or infirmity, or another ESSENTIAL reason, (such as temporary overseas employment). You must however state that reason on the back of the form.

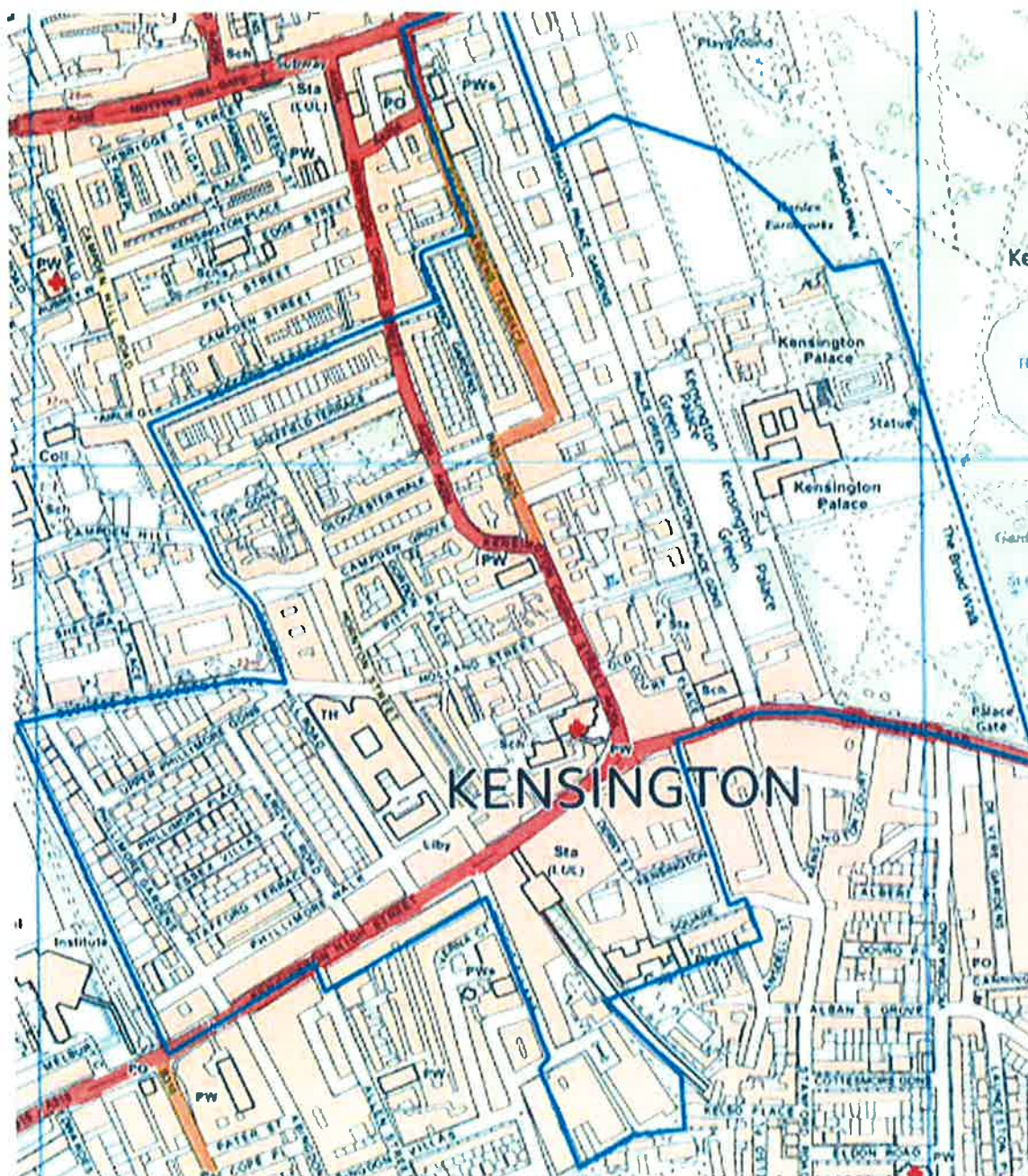
Persons of good standing with a Church NOT in communion with the Church of England, but which subscribes to the Doctrine of the Holy Trinity, may also be enrolled under the same terms as for those residents outside the parish boundary. *They should tick the THIRD (bottom) Box opposite.*

DATA PROTECTION ACT:
