## Message from Mother Emma

Alleluia! Christ is risen!

It was absolutely wonderful to be able to journey through Holy Week and Easter with so many of you last week, across all those different church services and online, and the joyous moment when we were able to sing "Thine be the Glory" in the Long Playground at the end of the Eucharist (thanks to the last-minute new regulation that we could sing socially distanced outside) will stay with me as particularly special for a very long time! We also offer our warm congratulations to the six adults baptized during the Easter Vigil on Saturday evening, and are delighted to welcome them into our church fellowship.

My huge thanks go to all those who helped to make the week so very moving and inspiring; to those in the parish office who put everything together, those who cleaned the church and did the flowers, our lovely musicians, readers, children's leaders and sidespeople, and to Mother Alice, who, as well as sharing in the liturgies, heralded the Resurrection at the Easter Vigil with her beautiful singing of the Exsultet.

I do hope and pray that all of you are able to take some time to rest and recuperate following Easter and I look forward to seeing you back in church soon. As announced on Sunday, there will be no weekday worship in the church for two more weeks, but from 19<sup>th</sup> April onwards we shall be offering (as before the lockdown) daily Midday Prayer and two midweek Eucharists, as well as Morning Prayer on Zoom. However, **this Sunday we will have 8 am BCP, 9.30 Eucharist and 11.15 Matins in church** as usual – please sign up via Eventbrite – and Evening Prayer on Zoom at 5.30 pm.

**Our Annual Parochial Church Meeting (the equivalent of an AGM) will be taking place on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> April at 6.30 pm** and due to ongoing restrictions, the Church of England has again made provision for this to happen over Zoom. Everyone who is on our Electoral Roll is warmly invited to attend online, to hear about what has been happening in the church over the past year (much of it necessarily behind the scenes!), to elect churchwardens and PCC members and to contribute thoughts as we look ahead to the future. We shall be sending out the Zoom link to those on the Electoral Roll on the morning of 21<sup>st</sup> April, but if you are resident in the parish and not on the Roll and would like to attend for the election of the churchwardens, which you are entitled to do, please do ask Petter on [parishmanager@stmaryabbots.org.uk](mailto:parishmanager@stmaryabbots.org.uk) and he will send it to you. The full list of the Electoral Roll is up in the cloisters; please check your name is correctly recorded and I hope very much to welcome you at the APCM.
