


## In Our Prayers This Week

Do come and share in the spirit of the season, enjoy children’s activities, carols, seasonal food and drinks and buy some advance Christmas supplies! After the deprivations of last Christmas, we are very pleased to have an opportunity to spend time together in this way this year.
