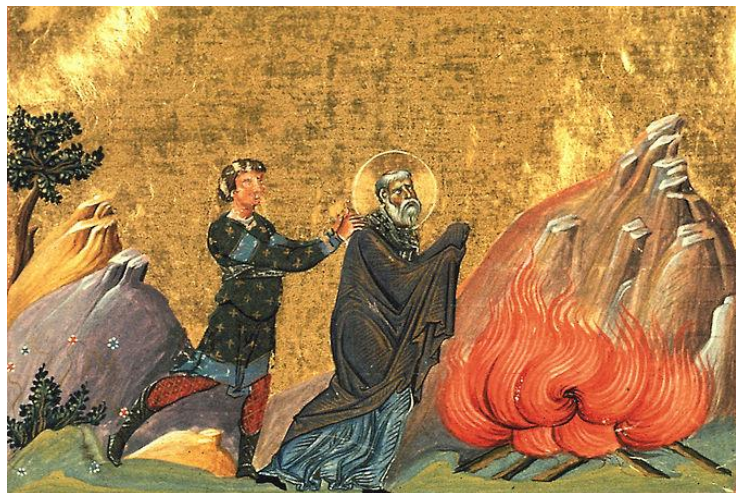

I hope our families are having a good half-term break, and that it hasn't been too frantic for you.

This Sunday is also known as Creation Sunday in some churches, and our readings encourage us to reflect on our place in creation: both as being subject to the forces of nature along with the rest of God's creatures, and as having a shared duty to steward God's creation well: for Him, for the poorest in the world, and for future generations. As we hear of Jesus's stilling of the waves, we also remember that we are always dependent on the God who made us, however in control we might sometimes kid ourselves we are. This is all the more important a lesson as we turn towards Lent and remind ourselves of the centrality of prayer in our lives.

This week, as I write, we have received the sad news that Bishop Graham Tomlin is leaving Kensington to head up the new Centre for Cultural Witness, seeking better ways to capture the imagination of people in our culture with the joy of our faith. We will be very sad to see +Graham go, which he does at the end of August, and wish him well when that time comes.
