
### Collect for Easter Day

## Message from Mother Emma

We have walked with Christ through the dark days of Holy Week, and now we rejoice together at his bursting from the tomb! We welcome you all to St Mary Abbots on Easter Day and are glad to be offering Choral Services at the 9.30 am Eucharist, 11.15 am Matins AND 5.30 pm Evensong as we celebrate together. Between the 9.30 Festal Eucharist and the 11.15 Festal Matins, we shall be offering celebratory refreshments on the Long Playground; you are warmly invited to join us, and Martina will be offering a children's Easter trail in front of the school building.

This has been another difficult year for many, and our hearts go out to all those who continue to suffer in Ukraine and across the world, but the Resurrection of Christ from the dead inspires us to have hope and to share Christ's hope, love and compassion with others.

As we walk forward through Eastertide, there is much to give thanks for in our community. Some of us may have a sense of new life as we are released from the hardest moments of the lockdown and as elements of our fuller liturgy and community activity are able to return. I am so grateful to the wonderful parish staff and my fellow clergy, as well as to everyone who volunteers, prays, and lends their joyful, prayerful and supportive presence to our services and events. As we build back, we continue to ask if you would consider helping in different ways – as welcomers, readers, servers or with our refreshments or outreach teams. Please do contact Fr Christopher or me if you would like to serve the church in any of these ministries.

We now turn our attention to our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, and ask you to SAVE THE DATE: **at a Festal Eucharist on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> May at 11.15 am we shall be celebrating the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the current church's consecration** on 14<sup>th</sup> May 1872. Our preacher that day will be the Archdeacon of Middlesex, the Ven Richard Frank, who took office in lockdown and will be visiting us in this capacity for the first time. There will be a short Children's Eucharist at 9.30 am, and everyone from both services will be invited to picnic in the Vicarage garden afterwards. On that day we shall also be providing full details of our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary projects for the church (for which the Friends of St Mary Abbots are already kindly fundraising!), and also opening an exhibition of photographs of sacred objects at St Mary Abbots, and releasing a programme of events for people of all ages to take place over our Anniversary summer and autumn.

It is an absolute joy to minister within such a wonderful community, and I, together with Fr Christopher, the churchwardens and all the parish staff, wish you, and everyone you love, a joyful and blessed Easter.

### 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebrations

We will be arranging a series of events throughout the year to celebrate our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary, starting with an Anniversary Service on 15<sup>th</sup> May, and continuing with a series of talks, exhibitions, concerts and social events. ### The Friends launch the 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Accessibility Appeal

The Friends of St Mary Abbots have launched a 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Appeal to raise £50,000 needed to provide a new, tastefully designed and safe accessibility ramp at the main cloister door designed to replace the unsightly and rather unsafe temporary structure which has somehow lingered there for many years longer than it should!

The new structure will be architect designed and in keeping with the fine stonemasonry at the Cloister Doors.

**To encourage you to give to the full, the Friends will donate £1 for every £1 you donate up to the value of £25,000.** So if we can together raise £25,000, the Friends will donate £25,000 from their funds raised in recent years. 25% Gift Aid can also be claimed on donations from UK Taxpayers.
