Message from Mother Emma

First of all, may I wish any of you whom I haven't yet seen a very happy New Year on behalf of all of us on the clergy and staff teams at St Mary Abbots! It was such a privilege to share with you all in our glorious worship over the past month, and we are also so very grateful for all your kind prayers, cards, messages, emails and gifts over the Christmas period. We are extremely lucky to serve such a wonderful community.



On Friday we celebrated the Feast of the Epiphany, as the Magi finally arrive at the stable and worship the newborn King, marking the end of the Christmas season. We have taken down the Christmas decorations and now move into the evocative season of Epiphanytide.

This Sunday we are celebrating the Feast of the Baptism of Christ. Although the 9.30 Eucharist was previously advertised as a Baptism, it will now be more of a Family Eucharist, as we all come back together. This means there will not be separate children's provision this Sunday, through there will be activities as usual for them to do in the pews or in the Children's Chapel. Our full Sunday groups will return next week.



A piece of exciting news for this New Year is that for the next six months we shall be joined from time to time on the clergy team by the Revd Dr Cecilie Jorgensen Strommen. Revd Cecilie is a priest in the Lutheran Church of Norway, who was ordained in the Ecumenical Chapel in Geneva in 1992. Thanks to her husband, Wegger's, career in the Norwegian Foreign Service, Cecilie and her two

daughters have moved around the world, living in, among others, Israel, Geneva, New York, Washington DC, London and Oslo. Cecilie says she has been blessed to be able to serve as a priest in many of these places, including at St Edmund's Anglican Church in Oslo, the (Episcopalian) National Cathedral in Washington DC and most recently, St Olave's Norwegian Seamen's Church in London. Cecilie studied theology in Oslo, and also has a BA in Hebrew, a Masters in Sacred Theology and is a Doctor of Ministry, having written a thesis on the "Sanctification of the Ordinary". She is very drawn to the liturgies and language of the Church of England, and the way they embrace life, and since her daughter's marriage blessing was held at SMA in September (they live within the parish boundaries), has been a regular member of the Morning Prayer online group. We are delighted, that thanks to the shared Communion between the "Porvoo" Nordic Churches and the C of E, we have been able to obtain permission for Cecilie to officiate at our services. We look forward immensely to welcoming her at St Mary Abbots and learning from her wide experience during the remainder of their posting in London.

Please may I encourage you to read the newsletter carefully, as most of our regular activities will be starting up again next week, and there will be some new ones to watch out for! As we move forward into the New Year, we seek to live out our Mission Action objectives of Welcome, Discipleship and Outreach in God's name and to his glory.
