A reminder that Wednesday 22nd February will be Ash Wednesday when we mark the beginning of Lent, with the sign of the Cross on our foreheads demonstrating our penitence and faith. The ash is created using last year's blessed palm crosses, so if you have one at home, please do bring it in to the Vestry for burning in preparation. Lent is a time for prayer, study and acts of service. A lovely group of us last year took part in the London Walk in support of the charity Glass Door (see photo) and raised over £4,000 in sponsorship.
