Message from Mother Emma

It was good to see so many of you at our Ash Wednesday services this week, as we marked the beginning of the solemn season of Lent. The Eucharistic Prayer for the season of Lent tells us, "In these forty days you



lead us into the desert of repentance, that through a pilgrimage of prayer and discipline we may grow in grace and learn to be your people once again. Through fasting, prayer and acts of service, you bring us back to your generous heart. Through study of your holy word, you open our eyes to your presence in the world and free our hands to welcome others into the radiant splendour of your love."

As we begin our Lenten journey together, we hope that you will be able to share in some of the ways St Mary Abbots is offering to help us fulfil this aspiration. There are many opportunities for prayer and study, from our online Bible Study on Monday mornings to our "Bitesize Bible" groups before school on Tuesdays. In addition, we shall be offering a dedicated Lenten study group in the Holland Chapel at 4 pm on Sundays during Lent, beginning this Sunday (26th), and study Henri Nouwen's book, ""The Return of the Prodigal Son". If you would like to join us, please come along on Sunday - we have some copies of the book available, or you can obtain your own copy. Participants will be warmly invited (though not obliged!) to stay on for Evensong at 5.30 pm. Emma, our Lenten artist-in-residence will be setting up this coming weekend, as she begins to create her own painting based on the narrative of the Prodigal Son, who is himself brought back to the generous heart of the Father. Martina will be distributing copies to families of the Church of England's Lenten book for children, "Dust and Glory – A Lent journey of faith, failure and forgiveness", which is in itself inspired by the book called "Failure", written by our new Bishop of Kensington, Emma Ineson, which is the Archbishop of Canterbury's Lent book for this year, and which you might also like to read. We do hope that you will be able to take part in one of these disciplines, so that we can truly experience the sense of travelling together as "Christ's pilgrim people".

We are delighted to welcome Clare Heard, Licensed Lay Minister in the Holland Park Benefice, to preach for us at todays 9.30 am Eucharist. We shall also be commissioning and praying for our Confirmation Candidates, as they too set off on a new stage of their Christian journey, preparing for Confirmation on 25th May.

Finally, I am glad to say that the work has now begun on the tower and spire, so we hope that all masonry will be firmly in place in a couple of weeks' time! (See photos on the gallery page of the website). During this period, the Garth and the North Passage remain closed for safety reasons, but we look forward to re-opening the East Churchyard, and beginning the work to restore the Friends' Millennium exterior lighting very soon. The final drawings showing the re-hanging of the South Doors to ensure full accessibility in connection with our ramp project are now with the Diocesan Advisory Committee, so watch this space as all our fabric projects begin to take shape this Spring.

Almighty God, may we, by the prayer and discipline of Lent, enter into the mystery of Christ's sufferings; that by following in the Way we may come to share in the glory, through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen [Common Worship, Night Prayer in Lent]
