Message from Mother Emma

During another busy week at St Mary Abbots we were delighted to welcome Bishop Emma, the new Bishop of Kensington, for a tour of St Mary Abbots School as part of her introductory visit to the Kensington Deanery. Afterwards she briefly



visited the church, where she met some of the parish team in the church and discussed our recent projects and plans for the future.

On our projects, the current maintenance of the stonework of the tower and spire has almost finished, with our intrepid head Virger Simon climbing up to the top of the spire to see the progress. We shall also have an update on the lighting restoration project next week, and the ramp the week after!

Mother Alice has started a Monday Morning Prayer Group for parents (and others, of course) at 9 am after the school drop off so if you would like to join this please come along. The existing Zoom Morning Prayer at 8 am will also continue. Lastly, please note that Bitesize Bible pre-school group, where children study a bible story before eating a snack, has moved from Tuesday to Wednesday at 8.35.

This week Emma, our in-house artist started her painting of the Prodigal Son in the Holland Chapel and it has been fascinating to see how the piece is taking shape. She has kindly provided some preliminary works which can be seen on the boards behind her, so please go and look after the service.

Today we look forward to hearing our children's choir at the 9.30 Family Eucharist. If your child would like to take part next month the rehearsals start at 8.45am. Later this afternoon we continue our Lent Study Group at 4pm, this time looking at the Younger Son, and you are welcome to join us, even if you weren't able to attend last week's session.

The children's choir will be reassembling on Sunday 19th March at the 9.30 am Eucharist for a special Mothering Sunday service with a children and parent choir. Please let Mother Alice know if you would like to join.

On 10th March applications will close for the role of Hall Manager. The position is varied, requiring someone to manage the commercial aspects of the hall, with its onsite ballet school and car park, and to manage the upkeep and maintenance of the whole site. The role would require someone with a little events experience - booking and building relationships with theatre companies, community groups, school parents, arranging receptions for weddings, baptisms and funerals. The Hall Manager also works closely with the rest of the team on joint events both in the garden and church and would manage the halls website and build up its social media presence.
