
In Our Prayers This Week

Message from Mother Emma

It was very good to host a talk for the Victorian Society last night at the church on the two Sister Cemeteries of Brompton and Kensal Green, and the participants enjoyed being in the truly Victorian setting of St



Abbots. We are hoping to share more events with the Victorian Society later in the year, so please keep a look out!

Tickets are now available for Handel's Messiah with our professional choir and the Purcell Players, on the evening of Palm Sunday (April 2nd). We very much hope that you will buy a ticket and join us for this very special evening as we begin Holy Week, supporting our choir and the musical tradition of St Mary Abbots.

As Lent draws to a close, we shall be holding our final Lent group this Sunday at 4 pm, and would be delighted to welcome anyone who would like to come, whether or not you have been able to attend earlier sessions. The painting by Emma, our artist-in-residence, inspired by the parable of the Prodigal Son is also reaching completion; please do take the opportunity to speak with her about it, and there is a particular chance for children and families to do so after the 9.30 am Eucharist this Sunday.

Passiontide begins this Sunday, and the crosses in the church are veiled in purple as we prepare for Holy Week, which begins with the procession and dramatized reading of the Passion at 9.30 am on Palm Sunday on April 2nd. Holy Week and Easter cards have been distributed and are available in church - please do take one (or look on the services page of the website). Someone who was going to be away told me they were glad to have taken one, as they saw that we are offering Online Reflections in the first part of Holy Week, which can be accessed even if you are on holiday. St Mary Abbots School's Passion Service will be held on Thursday 30th, as the children act out the story of Holy Week, with narration, songs and prayers, at 9.30 am. Please pray for your clergy and all the members of the Parish Office during these final weeks of preparation for Holy Week and Easter, that every element of our services may truly enable everyone in our congregations to draw closer to God during this time which forms the foundation of our faith.

And our weekly Fabric update:


The work on the external lighting has continued successfully this week, as you may have seen if you are passing. We apologise that the access to the Garth is still closed, but want to be sure that all the electricals are safe and complete before we allow people into the area. We believe that (all going to plan), the lights will be ready to switch on again for Easter Eve (April 8th), revealing St Mary Abbots once again as a beacon of light and hope in our community. Our thanks go to the Friends of St Mary Abbots for their original installation of the lighting at the time of the Millennium.



We are also delighted to say that the PCC met and passed the final drawings for the South Door access ramp (the subject of the Friends' 150th Anniversary project) and these have presented been to the Diocesan Advisory Committee for their input. Following this meeting, one clarification was needed on the handrail which will be needed, but once the PCC have approved this, we can apply for the Faculty (legal church permission) and go out for the final consultation. All plans and drawings will be displayed in the church during this time and we can then move on to the final building stage! We are excited and thankful that two of the aspirations in our three-year Mission Action Plan are already coming to fruition, as we work to demonstrate in the church's fabric the warm and inclusive welcome we seek to offer to all.
