Today is Palm Sunday! At the beginning of Holy Week, as we begin to walk with Jesus on his journey to the Cross, we remember his Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem,



riding on a donkey, as people laid palms on the road and greeted him with cries of "Hosanna". Tonight at 5.30 pm is our performance of Handel's Messiah, parts II and III, which tell the story of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. Tickets are available on the door. Please come to support our professional choir as they sing alongside the Purcell Players and raise money for the church's work, and share with us in this beautiful interpretation of the story which lies at the heart of our faith.

Next week is Holy Week, and we shall be offering a daily Eucharist at 12 noon on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. This is at our usual time, but will replace Sunday on Monday and the BCP Holy Communion Service with a Eucharist and a reflection on the final week of Jesus' life. The reflection will later be available online, from 7 pm, with a service of Night Prayer, so that wherever you are, you can join us on this journey. Links can be found on the 'services' page of our website.

Our services for the Triduum, or Great Three Days leading up to Easter Day, are shown on the posters in the church and on the 'Services' page of the website, and I shall be emailing next week with further details.


