
In our Prayers this week


This evening we are starting a new innovation. Anglican chant has been one of the glories of the Church of England for centuries and is used for the Responses, Psalm, Magnificat and Nunc Dimittis at Evensong, when the congregation are invited to join in. However, many of us (and I include myself!) did not grow up learning this tradition and sometimes find it hard to follow the chant. Mother Alice is forming a voluntary choir to lead us as we learn the music together. If you are either familiar with Anglican chant already and prepared to help lead others, or if you enjoy singing and would like to join a voluntary choir and learn a different genre of music, we would be absolutely delighted to hear from you, or to see you at Evensong this Sunday (5 30 pm). The voluntary choir will continue to lead Evensong on the second Sunday of each month going forward, and in due course start to sing an anthem in place of the existing organ piece.

We are delighted that Vera Ezumah, our placement ordinand, who will preach at the 9.30 am Eucharist today and we welcome Antonia, Daisy and Sterling who will be baptised at that service.

Next Thursday (19th May) is the Feast of the Ascension. This is the fourth most important festival in the Christian Church, where we remember Christ ascending into Heaven forty days after his Resurrection. We are reminded of the promise of Ascension in the Eucharistic Prayer for that day: "By the glory of his resurrection, he opened the way to life eternal and by his ascension, gave us the sure hope that where he is we may also be." As well as the 9.30 am School Eucharist we shall offer a Choral Eucharist at 12 noon – do join us.

God of power, you are strong to save and you never fail those who trust in you; keep us under your protection and spread abroad your reign of peace through Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen (Common Worship, Daily Prayer, response to Psalm 125)
