Message from Mother Emma

I am writing as we are putting the finishing touches to the liturgy and music for our Christmas services, before the parish office closes for the holiday. We



are looking forward to welcoming you to St Mary Abbots Church this weekend as we come together on Sunday and Monday to give thanks for the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On Christmas Eve (today) is our Crib Service for children and families, where children are invited to come dressed as a character from the Nativity and to take part as we tell the story of Jesus' birth with lots of participation, and sing familiar carols. At 11 pm comes the beautiful, moving and

mystical service of Midnight Mass; we celebrate the Eucharist together by candlelight with Christmas music from our professional choir and then, as midnight comes, we lay the baby Jesus in the manger and bless the crib, singing, "Yea, Lord, we greet thee, born this happy morning." It is a moment which never fails to touch my heart with awe and joy. Tomorrow, on Christmas morning, there will be a BCP Eucharist at 8 am, Festal Choral Eucharist at 9.30 am, Festal Choral Matins at 11.15 am, and a service of Holy Communion with Carols at the Crib at 5.30 pm. Everyone is very welcome at any or all of these services.

Please note that during Christmas week (26th – 30th December), there will be no Morning Prayer online, and the church will be opening at 10 am every morning, instead of 8.30 am. The Parish Office will be closed until 3rd January, but there will always be a member of the clergy on duty to take the lunchtime Eucharist and the 5.30 pm Evening Prayer in church, who can also be contacted if needed.

Once again this year, it has been an absolute privilege to serve as your Vicar. As at this time, we pray for Mother Alice and her family, moving this week to her new parish, and for Fr Christopher celebrating his first Christmas in the US, we give thanks for both Fr Evan and Fr Tim and for the wonderful start they have made in their ministry here. I am so grateful to my churchwardens, PCC, parish staff, volunteers and to all members of our congregations for their love, faithfulness and devotion to God's Church. I pray that, wherever you celebrate Christmas, you will find peace and joy, and I wish you every blessing for the New Year.

Your light has shone in our darkened world through the child-bearing of blessed Mary; grant that we who have seen your glory may daily be renewed in your image and prepared like her for the coming of your Son, who is the Lord and Saviour of all.
