## Message from Mother Emma

It was so good to worship with many of you over Holy Week and Easter; we were delighted to see you, to remember the Crucifixion and celebrate Christ's Resurrection together. I am so very



grateful to the clergy, parish staff, choir and volunteers who worked so hard to prepare and lead all our services, to enhance them with beautiful music, and to make the church a wonderful and welcoming place to be during this holy time.

We are now in Eastertide, the season of the church which lasts from Easter Day until the Feast of the Ascension on Thursday 9th May, and we remember in our Gospel readings Jesus' many different Resurrection appearances to his disciples. The other Sunday readings at the Eucharist during Eastertide come from the Acts of the Apostles, the record (probably by St Luke) of the earliest church, as followers of Jesus began to reflect on his life, ministry, teaching, death and Resurrection, and what these meant for them and for their lives. We shall be thinking this year about the church as understood by those earliest followers and the ways in which we can learn from them to grow and strengthen our own faith and community.

One thing we would like to do during this season is to begin our service a little differently. We are so aware that in a church the size of ours, those who sit near the back or gather near the Children's Chapel feel a very long way away for the clergy at the High Altar, and in order to include everyone equally in our worship, we shall be doing the first parts of the service (the Greeting, the Prayers of Penitence and the Absolution) from the West Doors, before we continue our procession up to the High Altar. Please could we encourage you, even if you normally spend time in the Children's Chapel, to start the service by sitting in one of the pews with your children, so they can share in this worship for themselves before going out to our Sunday Groups? As we make our confession through the prayers of penitence and hear the words of God's absolution and forgiveness, this is an opportunity to teach our children about God's love and forgiveness, as well as remembering it for ourselves.

As we look ahead to summer, please do keep an eye out for the extra events being organised in the Church, beginning with the free lunchtime concert by the Brighton College Chamber Choir. The following Friday the Royal College of Music Friday lunchtime concerts resume after the holidays.

Risen Lord Jesus, as Mary Magdalene met you in the garden on the morning of your resurrection, so may we meet you today and every day; speak to us as you spoke to her; reveal yourself as the living Lord; renew our hope and kindle our joy and send us to share the good news with others. Amen [Common Worship; Times and Seasons 2006]
