We would also very much welcome your input and participation as we work together as a parish to develop different aspects of our life together and to raise up people who would like to take on new areas of responsibility within the different ministries of the church. One of the first ways we can do this is by developing still further the wonderful work Martina is doing to support our parents in sowing the seeds of faith and Christian practice amongst our children and young people. 
