












Who are the Friends?

Formed in 2001 the Friends are made up of parishioners of the church, residents of the Kensington community, local businesses and associations and members in other countries who wish to be associated with the work of the Friends in helping to maintain the fabric and fittings of this fine example of Sir George Gilbert Scott's legendary church architecture.

The Friends is a lively association deeply involved in the St Mary Abbots church community and undertaking a range of projects which we support through fund raising, bequests and sponsorship of events.

Successful projects funded by the Friends include the installation of a new Chiming Bell in the church tower (the first new bell since 1872), provision of new carpeting around the altars, improvements to lighting inside the churchyard, donation of a new set of surplices for both the adult and children's choirs in support of the excellent musical traditions of St Mary Abbots and many other works to repair and maintain this splendid church, often referred to informally in the area as the Pro-Cathedral of Kensington!
