Food Bank

There is additional need over the summer please continue to support the work of the foodbank.

A typical food donation includes:

- Food Items: Cereal; Soup; Pasta; Rice; Tinned tomatoes/ pasta sauce; Lentils, beans and pulses; Tinned meat; Tinned vegetables; Tea/coffee; Tinned fruit; Biscuits; UHT milk; Fruit juice;
 Non-food items:
- Toiletries – deodorant, toilet paper, shower gel, shaving gel, shampoo, soap, toothbrushes, tooth paste, hand wipes
 - Household items –detergent, laundry powder, washing up liquid
 - Feminine products – sanitary towels and tampons
 - Baby supplies – nappies, baby wipes and baby food.
